
Categories	Action
Students registered for 2 Unit 1 CAPE Subjects	Add either Communication Studies or Caribbean Studies
Students registered for 3 Unit 1 CAPE Subjects	Replace one of the Unit 1 CAPE Subject with Communication Studies or Caribbean Studies
Students registered for 4 Unit 1 CAPE Subjects	Replace one of the Unit 1 CAPE Subject with Communication Studies or Caribbean Studies
Students registered for 2 Unit 1 CAPE Subjects and CSEC	Add either Communication Studies or Caribbean Studies

We know that quite a bit of the CAPE students is compliant in this regard and have already registered for a compulsory subject. For those that have not and fall in either of the above listed categories the Schools office will be in touch with you either by a phone call or email with regards to the selection of either subject and the time of the class that you would join.
